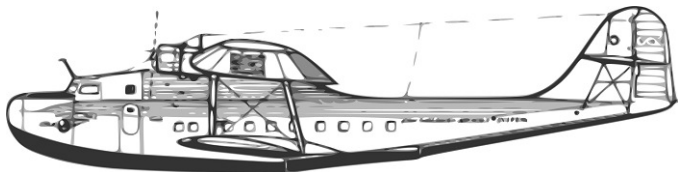

Not a lot to share this month; just hope to see more folks out at the field.

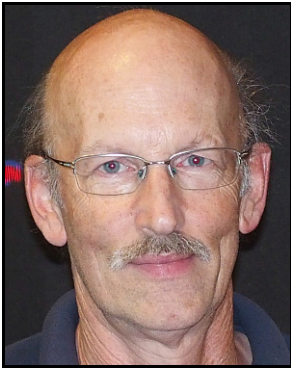

Mike is expecting to continue with field improvements there are many projects pending.

Vice Presidents Report.

Dan Sievert reminded us to please use the flight stations. There are now 5 of them plainly marked by red PVC piping at the flightline. This is where we are supposed to stand while we fly. All of us please use the flight stations and use common sense when flying!

Treasury Report.

Will reports we are now 186 members and is please with the growth of the Club. The "Goes in a" is of course the dues from the new members. The "Goes out a" this passed month was new checks, pizza, raffle funds, field materials and badges

Secretary's report.

Flightline

Phil Cole was not in attendance but continues to provide our Flightline on time. Thanks Phil!

Safety officers report.

Bill Stetner could not attend.

We did have a discussion about safety in his absence. Several points were made: Please respect the south edge of the runway as the southern limit for flight. All flying should occur to the north of this limit.

Please refrain from flying directly towards the flight stations and pits (You may be in complete control but it can give the guys behind you the creeps).

Carefully consider the risk of flying when you are alone at the field. An accident is never predictable or choosy about whom it punishes. If you catch a moving prop with nobody around to help, you could easily be in over your head.

Field Chairman.

Dave O'Riordan says it's time for some Handicapped signage to reserve some parking spaces close for those who need them. He would also like to see more start up benches.

Chief flight instructor.

Dave Neves reported no new soloists last month. He also reminded us of the availability of the club trainer.

New Business.

This is the time every year that the club is supposed to conduct elections, so anyone interested in a position can step up. It seems all in attendance are satisfied with the way things are going. No one expressed an interest in an elected position at this time.

Mike announced that the club received a grant from the AMA for field improvement! We applied for back in March. It is official - we were awarded that grant and now we need to make enough improvements this year at a 10 to 1 level to keep all the money the club has been granted. That means we will need LOTS of help with projects.

The solar power project is still active. Issues are to seek better pricing, decide how many batteries we really need, design and placement of the battery bunker.
